

CYC MOORING & STORAGE CHARGES 2025

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

In line with the Objects of the Club, the priority for the allocation of moorings and storage ashore should be to promote and facilitate Members wishing to sail. Where sufficient moorings and storage space exist other vessels or craft may be accommodated.

The purpose of making a charge for members to moor, beach, launch and store their boats is to offset some of the costs associated with the repair and upkeep of the moorings, grounds maintenance costs and rental charges.

The General Committee is responsible for allocating moorings and space for storing Members boats and equipment. If demand exceeds availability, the Committee will do its best to accommodate Members requests but sometimes the Committee will need to restrict or reject some applications, Club Rule Section 10 para 2 refers.

LONG TERM STORAGE

The Club has insufficient space for Members to use it for the Long Term Storage of their boat. The General Committee recognises that Members cannot always make use of their boats, perhaps because of repairs, maintenance, or ill-health and so some boats will not be launched for a few years. Notwithstanding Club Rule Section 10 para 3f, when demand exceeds space available, Members whose boats have not been launched for a period of 4 years or more may be asked to remove their boat from the CYC.

When this becomes likely the General Committee will inform the owner that their boat can no longer be stored at the CYC giving Members at least 12 months' notice before their boat (and trailer if appropriate) must be removed. Boat storage charges will apply until the boat has been removed, with the last year being charged at a pro rata rate.

The Club retains the right to refuse permission for any boat unsuitable for storage ashore, or that contravenes the requirements of the lease, or other local bylaws.

APPLICATION

Members wishing to moor, beach or store any vessel or equipment should apply to the treasurer by the 31st January each year, using the CYC Mooring & Application Form. Approvals and allocations will then be made. Members wishing to apply at other times of year are to use the same form and will be accommodated if space permits.

Members need to apply if they wish to store tenders, other watercraft, engines and trailers at the CYC. Permission will be given where space exists. Members are reminded that all boats, trailers and personal equipment is to be clearly marked to identify the owner.

HARBOUR DUES

All boats launched are required to pay harbour dues, a fee set and administered by the Warkworth Harbour Commissioners. This fee is paid to the Commissioners through the CYC Treasurer when applying for a mooring or day launched storage. Members who day launch, but who do not store their boat at the CYC, are required to pay the daily or weekly fee and are to inform the treasurer of their use. Boats permitted to be stored and not used during the year do not pay harbour dues.

Below are the CYC Annual Boat & Equipment, Mooring and Storage Charges for 2025 as agreed by the General Committee.
